Professional hunters usually recommend an arrow of a minimum of 420 grains for hunting elks. Yet the bows manufactured these days are more efficient than they ever were. How Many Arrows in Your Quiver for Elk Hunting?While it can carry more, hunters typically carry around ten arrows in their quivers. They might not be needed. But you certainly need at least three to take follow-up shots at your target. Having more arrows is definitely good, but it does increase the load you have to carry, so three arrows are ideal. SourceWe think that heavier arrows are more suited for recurve elk hunts. They are more competent at absorbing the kinetic energy generated by the bow. You need a good length-weight combination to be successful. Think around at least ten grains per inch of the arrow length without the broadhead. This takes us at around 500 grains. How Much Kinetic Energy Does it Take to Kill an Elk?The recommended kinetic energy range for big game hunting is 42 to 64 ft-lbs. You may be aware that modern, hot-rod compound bows manufactured nowadays are perfectly capable of producing 70+ ft-lbs. At this rate, even if you use a heavier arrow, you will still have some energy to spare after what is required to harvest an elk.
